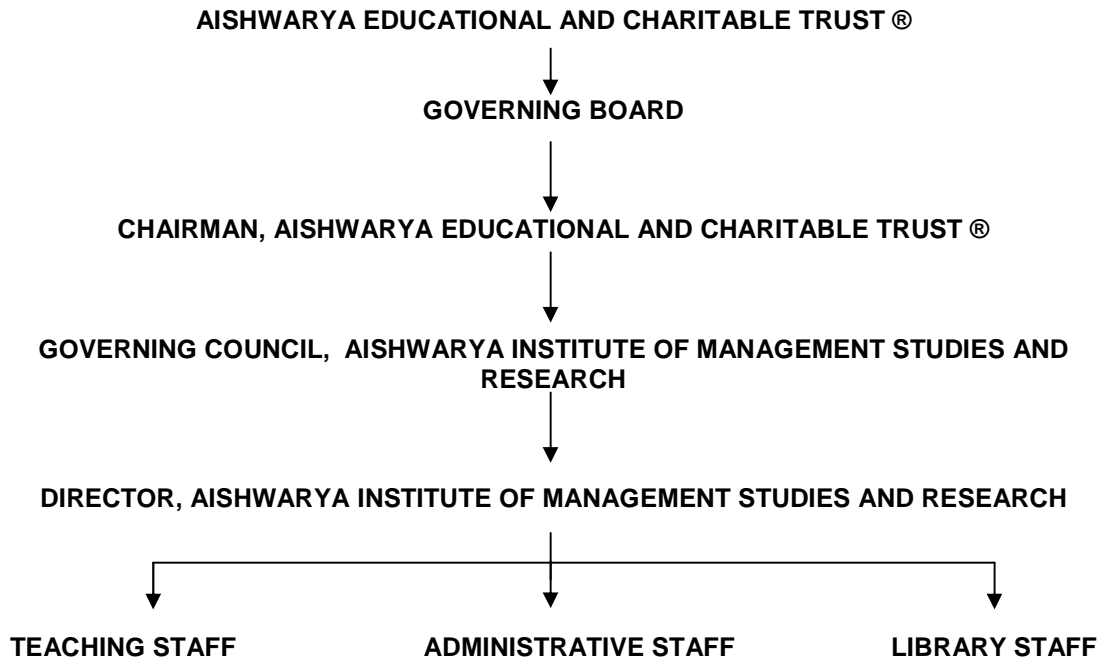

A Common Entrance Test (PGCET) followed by single window counseling is carried out for allotment of MBA seats. Our Institute participates in this process for filling up the 30 MBA seats. Remaining 30 seats are being filled up through any of the approved tests like CAT, MAT, XAT, ATMA, KMAT etc.
